

Official statement

Pro2Be Esports is thrilled to announce the management of its first international player, the videogame of reference is MotoGP from Milestone.

The player is the Indonesian Putut Maulana, 29 years old from Banjarbaru, South Kalimantan, know in game with the nickname “Moe”.

Putut has been the only non EU contender to earn access at the live finals in 2018.

In the 2019 season of MotoGP eSport, he shone among the best of the “Rest Of The World” region gaining access at the Pro Draft at the first challenge available at Termas de Río Hondo – Argentina – with a lap completed in 1’31:626, fastest record on PC platform.

He has also taken part at the challenges #2 and #3, who took place on the circuits of Assen and Sachsenring. Despite he was already qualified to the Pro Draft, also in these occasions he managed to set the fastest laps on PC – “Rest Of The World” region – in 1’28:858 and 1’16:451.

Fabio Battista’s words, Esports Director of Pro2Be:

“ We are very excited to manage the best pro player of South East Asia who already qualified at live events in the past. It has been a great teamwork and therefore I thank Arcangelo to have closed the deal. The Indonesian community is very hot right now and it is actively participating at these online challenges. The first days of August will be crucial to qualify for the world championship and we are confident that Putut can reach it. “

Moe will then join Andrea Saveri, Michael Amara and Davide Gallina in the MotoGP eSport roster managed by Pro2Be Esports, increasing the overall to four riders.
